

Windsor Recycling Facts

About The Cart

- Carts are all 96 gallon in size with wheels and a lid
- The first cart is FREE and on a first come first serve basis
- Customers will need to purchase any additional carts
- Call office to get put on a priority list to receive your cart
- Carts/Recycling will continue to be picked up on same corresponding day as trash
- Recyclables are comingled in the cart (mixed together) simply throw all your items loosely in the same container

About Our Program

The recycling service is available to Windsor's trash customers

Recyclables are collected and stored until a complete truck load is made. A load of recycling is then taken to a MRF (Material Recovery Facility) where they are sorted and prepared to be sold to an end user

Windsor doesn't make any money by collecting recyclables but every 96 gallon can of recyclables collected is 96 gallons that doesn't fill up our landfill.

Recycling must be in Blue Recycling container

What can be recycled?

- Emptied and rinsed or flattened
 - Cans
 - Glass bottles and jars
 - Plastic jugs and bottles
 - Paper cartons, cardboard, & newspaper

What NOT To Do!

- Do not put recyclables in bags
- No electronics
- No food
- No liquids
- No trash
- No clothing or fabrics
- No wires or hoses
- No tires
- No shredded paper
- No magazines/junk mail
- No plastic bags
- No batteries
- Do not overfill the cart

Remember To

- Empty and rinse glass and plastic bottles and jars
- Flatten cardboard
- Empty metal cans
